I write to object to the proposed third prison at Wymott, Ulnes Walton Lane.

I am a disabled mobility scooter user and have occasion to travel along Ulnes Walton Lane Which has always been quite precarious due to the amount of traffic which passes me at an alarming speed.

I have been made aware in a letter sent to me that the proposal for a third prison has been resurrected When I had read that it had been shelved.

My journey on this road, which is the only access road to the prison is precarious, dangerous and stressful, due to the speed and volume of vehicles on the road, a large proportion of which go to the prison, and the thought of the traffic getting heavier due to the proposed Expansion Fills me with dread.

There are no pavements or designated safe places to travel down This road, and it is common knowledge that youth use it in their time trial races from Tesco car park in Leyland as one of their routs to prove how fast they can complete the challenge. This is bad enough, but when I hear of this proposal Which Will undoubtedly increase the traffic volume substantially I feel I will be unable to use the road as it will be too busy dangerous and will cause me too much stress to even attempt my journey.

I would appreciate it if my concerns were addressed as I have had many near misses cars have passed me too close too fast, and in sometimes a very dangerous manner, which has left me compromised and distraught. Any increase in the traffic on this road would impact my ability to safely use the road to visit friends and ultimately my lifeline considerably.
